



In 2019, DHIC, Inc. (DHIC) and The Presbyterian Homes of North Carolina (PHI) acquired Capital Towers, the largest affordable housing property for seniors of limited means in Raleigh, NC. Our goal in doing so was not just to preserve and renovate this invaluable affordable housing resource, but also to ensure the residents have the resources they need to age in place successfully.

The COVID-19 pandemic has impacted the members of the Capital Towers community acutely. During these uncertain times, please consider providing every-day personal supplies and food for the nearly 200 senior adult residents living at Capital Towers in Raleigh, NC.
